


Pre-school and Nursery suggested activities.

Story time	Numbers/shapes	Working together
<p>Share a book with someone in your family. It can be your own story book or the book from our library.</p> <p>Listen to a story on Cbeebies/stories. Talk about the blurb on the back of the book, the illustrator and the author.</p>	<p>Walking around you house, see how many different shapes you can see, ie. Clock – circle, windows – square/rectangular, dinner plates, circles...</p>	<p>Help to lay the table for dinner. How many forks, knives, spoons do you need altogether for your family?</p> <p>Can you help to clear the table naming the different items as they clear them away, ie. Salt, pepper, plate, mug...</p>
<p>Share a book with a friend and talk about how you could make your own ending to the story.</p> <p>Talk about your favourite story that we have read at school, Monkey Puzzle, We're going on a bear hunt, Oliver's vegetables, Peace at last, Whatever next... Why did you like the book?</p>	<p>Draw a shape picture to share at Pre-school/Nursery with your friends. Name the shapes that you have used.</p> 	<p>Help your parents to put the washing into the machine. Name the different clothing items as you put them in.</p> <p>When the washing is finished, help to peg them on a line to dry. Can you make a pattern using the items of clothing, ie, sock, vest, sock, vest...</p>
<p>Share a book with your family – talk about why you like the story. Draw your favourite part of the story using the paper and pencils we have provided.</p>	<p>Sing some number songs with your family. You can find these on Youtube. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 once I caught a fish alive... 10 little numbers... There were 10 in the bed... Five little monkey's jumping on the bed</p>	<p>With your adults, can you cut up some fruit or vegetables to make a fruit salad or salad to eat together? Talk about the different textures of the food and describe how they taste.</p>

Draw a picture of the cake that you baked.

Play dough recipe.

2 cups of plain flour, 1 cup of salt, 2 teaspoon of cream tartar, 2 teaspoons of cooking oil, 2 cups of boiling water, food colouring, optional. Put all the ingredients in a bowl together and mix until a smooth dough is formed.
